

To our valued customers,

In response to Ontario's Proof of Vaccination Program, effective on Wednesday September 22nd, 2021, we want to inform our customers of the details that will apply to your entry to National Training Rinks (NTR)

- All customers will have to show valid proof of identification and proof of second vaccination not later than 14 days prior to entry to the facility. The only acceptable exemptions are listed below:
 - Anyone under 12 years of age
 - Anyone under 18 years of age AND entering the facility to participate on the ice.
 - Medical Exemptions
 - According to the guidance from the province, must provide a note from a physician, registered nurse in the extended class or nurse practitioner for a medical exemption for not being fully vaccinated. Requirements of the medical exemption note must include:
 - Name of contact information of the physician, registered nurse or nurse practitioner.
 - Logo or letterhead identifying the physician, registered nurse or nurse practitioner.
 - Statement that there is a medical reason for the individual's exemption from being fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
 - Any effective time-period for the medical reason which includes the date(s) the patron is seeking access to the business or organization.
- Parents of children in our programs who are not fully vaccinated will not be granted entry to the facility. If your child requires assistance getting dressed, you must do so outside. A member of our staff will escort your child onto the ice safely. Parents must remain on NTR property during the program.
- Patrons who are not fully vaccinated and are not permitted entry to the facility may only enter the facility for these reasons:
 - To use the washroom
 - When necessary for health and safety (child injury or illness).
- All customers entering the facility will still have to complete our COVID-19 Liability Waiver and Self-Screening questionnaire. The waiver can be found at www.ntrcanada.com/waiver.
- All players and spectators must continue to wear masks at all times in the facility with the exception of the playing surface and continue to maintain physical distancing requirements.

We appreciate that there are many opinions on the current Government policy. NTR has always and will continue to strictly adhere to the policies mandated by the Ontario Government in order to keep our doors open to you, our valued customers. Please arrive at the rink entrance with all needed documents in hand – there will be zero tolerance for any verbal harassment of our staff. Please be kind!!
